**Title:** Atlas 14 Floodplain Studies: An Update from the City of Austin  
**Bio:** Katina has spent her career in the Floodplain Modeling and Mapping Services group within Watershed Engineering at the City of Austin since she joined in 2005. She has been involved with the floodplain study & mapping process for 37 Austin area watersheds. She previously has led the WED Easement Release team and currently serves as lead for Commercial Floodplain Review for the City



of Austin.

Bio Clean is Forterra's newest line of environmental products for stormwater treatment. Products range from large object filtration to fine filtration including bio-filtration. Products, such as the Bio Clean Automatic retracting screen (ARS) are used on existing or new curb inlet structures and block large solids from entering the stormwater collection system. The Bio Clean curb inlet and catch basin inserts prevent large solids and sediment from clogging stormwater collection systems. The SciClone is a Hydrodynamic separator, which allows suspended solids to fall out of suspension and reduce TSS in stormwater flows. For finer filtration needs, the Modular Wetland uses both large and fine filtration methods including bio-filtration within one unit. The Modular Wetland Biofiltration system received TCEQ approval for use in the Edward's Aquifer, as well as a conditional approval in the City of Austin, and provides more treatment capacity in a smaller area.
